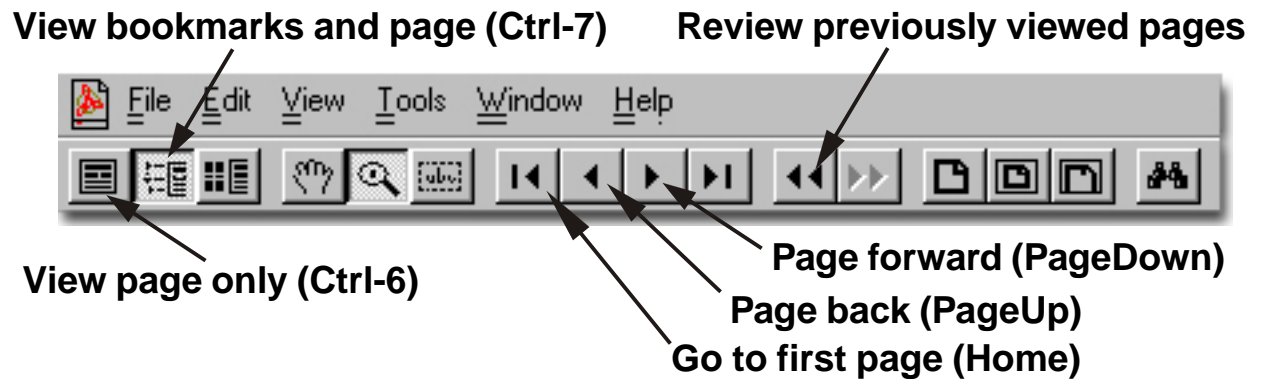


# Using The Pulsar Manual

## Various ways to get around in the Adobe Acrobat Reader Pulsar documentation:

- Browsing
- Toolbar buttons
- Bookmarks

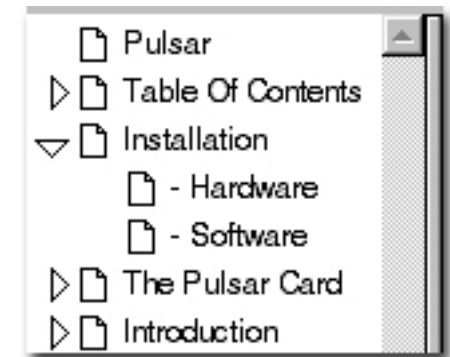


The hot tip: **The Pulsar Manual.pdf** is your gateway into the documentation. It provides a link to the main table of contents, which in turn provides links to individual chapters.

Each chapter begins with its own table of contents. The table entries (or in some cases, the device images) serve as clickable links. This gives you a chapter overview at a glance and lets you jump directly to specific points in a chapter. Each table of contents page also includes a direct link back to the main table of contents.

The toolbar buttons (above right) provide the means for moving around within a chapter. Use them to leaf page-by-page (or use the **PageUP** and **PageDown** keys), to return to the first page of a chapter (the chapter table of contents), or to "rewind" (and fast-forward) over the pages you've most recently viewed – including pages in other chapters.

**Bookmarks** (middle right) are also present in each chapter. These are normally hidden (to allow pages to be displayed as large as possible) but can be made visible using the **View bookmarks and page** button shown above, or via the Acrobat Reader **View** menu, or by hitting **Ctrl-I-7**. Via the bookmarks, you can jump around in a chapter or return to the main table of contents without needing to return to the chapter table of contents first.
